



INDIA EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL

Please provide a statement of marks and certificate from an All-India Senior School Certificate, Higher Secondary School Certificate, Intermediate Certificate, Pre-University Examination Certificate or an Indian School Certificate (and a photocopy of Secondary School [10th year] certificate).

Students who have documents that can be verified through an authorized online source should provide their Roll, School and Centre Numbers or similar relevant data from their examination card. If online verification is unavailable students will be required to obtain their results directly from CBSE, CISCE, NIOS, or the recognized State Board - student must request the attested photocopies be placed in an official sealed envelope, have the sealed envelope returned to the students, who in turn, mails it to MHC or have the Statement of Marks sent directly from the Examination Board.

Medicine Hat College does not accept notarized copies, but will accept copies taken by the proper authority, signed and placed in a sealed envelope that is not opened by the student, friends, family or agent.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

All academic transcripts should come directly to Medicine Hat College from the issuing institution. Please see notes on translation below.
