



ETHIOPIA EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL

Please provide your Higher Education Entrance Qualification and an academic school transcript.

These should be issued directly to Medicine Hat College in English by the Ministry of Education, National Organization for Examinations, and the school transcript should be issued in a sealed envelope by the Senior school attended.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

All academic transcripts should come directly to Medicine Hat College from the issuing institution. Please see notes on translation below.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Students from ETHIOPIA require English Language Proficiency or should take Medicine Hat College's English for Academic Purposes program prior to applying to a credit program. Students who attended an American or other international school may be exempt from English Language Proficiency but should check if their high school is exempt by emailing info@mhc.ab.ca

Students should refer to www.mhc.ab.ca/elp for a variety of ways to satisfy English Language Proficiency.

ACCEPTABLE ENGLISH TRANSLATIONS (IF TRANSCRIPT NOT ISSUED IN ENGLISH)

Students should always submit their official documents in the official language of issue. If the language of issue is not English, students should provide an acceptable English translation which should

- Be literal word-for-word translations presenting the same order of information and format as the original.
- Not leave any information out, be altered, or have information added. This means that all grades, comments, dates, and discussion must be included.
- Convey the information and format of the original.
- Have an appropriate corresponding original language document on file in the official language via the proper issuing authority.
