



WAEC or WASSCE EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL

If you attended a country like Guinea or another West African country that uses the WASSCEs please provide a photocopy of your West African Senior School Certificate and/or Western African School Certificate. Documents should be issued either directly from the examination board, or instead, with a valid scratch card in order to verify their authenticity.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

All academic transcripts should come directly to Medicine Hat College from the issuing institution. Please see notes on translation below.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Students from WAEC or WASSCE require English Language Proficiency. Students who attended a British, Canadian, American or other international school may be exempt from English Language Proficiency but should check if their high school is exempt by emailing info@mhc.ab.ca.

Medicine Hat College understands that English is the language of education in many West African Countries, but as the level of English can vary between regions, please note that this is a requirement for all students in order to support your success at the College.

ACCEPTABLE ENGLISH TRANSLATIONS (IF TRANSCRIPT NOT ISSUED IN ENGLISH)

Students should always submit their official documents in the official language of issue. If the language of issue is not English, students should provide an acceptable English translation which should

- Be literal word-for-word translations presenting the same order of information and format as the original.
- Not leave any information out, be altered, or have information added. This means that all grades, comments, dates, and discussion must be included.
- Convey the information and format of the original.
- Have an appropriate corresponding original language document on file in the official language via the proper issuing authority.
