Prospective Student from Republic of Korea (South Korea) should provide the following documents:

Equivalent to Alberta High School	<p>Document: Academic High School Leaving Certificate (Immungye Kodung Hakkyo)</p> <p>Issued: Academic transcripts should be issued in English by the institution attended.</p>
Post-Secondary Education and Transfer Credit	<p>Document: Official academic transcripts with all courses taken.</p> <p>Issued: Transcripts should come in a sealed envelope directly from the post-secondary institution to the Medicine Hat College by mail.</p> <p>Transfer Credit: <i>Students will receive an email to their mymhc.ca email account after receiving admission requiring detailed course outlines. For more information, please email transfer@mhc.ab.ca.</i></p>
English Language Proficiency	<p>Students should provide one of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Successful completion of Advanced ESL (ESL 99) at Medicine Hat College; 2. Successful completion of an Alberta Education English Language Arts course (or Canadian equivalent) that meets the academic requirements of the applicant's intended program of study; 3. A TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of 550 on the paper-based test, a score of 213 on the computer based test, or a score of at least 79 on the TOEFL iBT; 4. An IELTS (International English Language Testing System) overall band score of 6.0 with no band score less than 5.5; 5. Completion of an accredited diploma or degree at a Canadian post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction; or 6. A Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) with a minimum of 7 in each strand (for certificate or diploma programs only).
Acceptable English Translations (if Needed)	<p>Any documents not issued in English will also need acceptable English translations which:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be literal word-for-word translations presenting the same order of information and format as the original. • No information may be left out, altered, or added. This means that all grades, comments, dates, and discussion must be included. • The translation must convey the information and format of the original. • Have an appropriate corresponding original language document on file in the official language via the proper issuing authority.
