Prospective Student providing WAEC Examinations should provide the following documents:

Equivalent to Alberta High School	<p><b>Document:</b> West African Senior School Certificate (NECO results may also be acceptable if you contact <a href="mailto:balbano@mhc.ab.ca">balbano@mhc.ab.ca</a> in advance.</p> <p><b>Issued:</b> Directly from the West African Examination Council <u>or</u> a clear, legible, photocopy with a scratch card to verify results.</p>
Post-Secondary Education and Transfer Credit	<p><b>Document:</b> Academic transcripts</p> <p><b>Issued:</b> Post-Secondary transcripts must be sent directly from the institution to Medicine Hat College in a sealed envelope with the seal of the institution.</p> <p><b>Transfer Credit:</b> <i>Students will receive an email to their <a href="mailto:mymhc.ca">mymhc.ca</a> email account after receiving admission requiring detailed course outlines. For more information, please email <a href="mailto:transfer@mhc.ab.ca">transfer@mhc.ab.ca</a>.</i></p>
English Language Proficiency	<p>Students applying from a country with WASSCE exams presenting a passing grade in English are exempt from ELP when applying to Medicine Hat College programs. Students applying to collaborative programs are subject to the rules and considerations of the collaborative partner.</p>
Acceptable English Translations (if Needed)	<p>All documents should be issued in English.</p>
Other requirements/notes	<p>Students who have inconsistent birth dates on their documentation as a result of a rural birth should also provide documentation to show the date their birth was registered and a photocopy of valid picture identification.</p> <p>GCE/GCE "A" also acceptable</p>
