**Program Notes:**

- You are registered as a Medicine Hat College (MHC) student for Semesters 1-4. You will apply to the University of Calgary (U of C) in Semester 3 of the program and will be guaranteed acceptance if you meet all *satisfactory standing* in the first 4 semesters. You take the remainder of the program as a U of C student, but remain on the MHC campus.
- To maintain *satisfactory standing*, you must attain:
  - a CREDIT (CR) in clinical courses. A NON CREDIT (NC) must be repeated to advance to the next clinical course.
  - **a minimum of a C in all non-clinical nursing courses.**
  - **all non-nursing courses (semesters 1 & 2) require a minimum grade of C-**
  - maintain a GPA of 2.0 for each semester in Years 1 & 2.
- Students who
  - a) choose to take courses in a different configuration than shown above or;
  - b) drop or fail a class or;
  - c) want to take a course in the spring semester or from another institution should meet with their academic advisor for assistance.
