### Program Notes: Continuation Requirements

- A minimum grade of C+ is required in each PRNU course, BIOL 152 and PHSL 200
- You must maintain a C- in all other required courses
- A CR (Pass) is required in clinical and practicum courses for successful course completion

Students who are transferring from another nursing program or who have been away for more than one year, and will be entering into a clinical course, will be required to demonstrate competence in the knowledge and skills required for that clinical experience prior to the beginning of the clinical course. Students can only re-enter PN Program and must complete the program within 5 years of initial admission.

- Drop or fail a course.
- Want to take a course in the spring semester or from another institution.
