Producers: Farmers, ranchers, orchardists, and other primary agricultural and fish & seafood producers.



Processors: Food and beverage processors, manufacturers, and packagers.



Indigenous Organizations and/ or Not-For-Profits: Indigenous communities and organizations, industry associations, community organizations, university researchers, and other non-profit entities.



Ag-Tech/Technology: Agriculture or food equipment manufacturers, innovators, and developers of both hardware and software.

Program Types



Cost-Shared: The applicant is responsible for providing a percentage of the project cost in order to receive funding. Cost-sharing percentages differ between programs.



Repayable/Loan: The applicant must repay at least some of the funding received. Interest rates and repayment schedules differ between programs.



Non-Repayable: Funding received by the applicant does not have to be repaid.

losses. There may or may not
be a cost to participants
depending on the program.

These provide cash flow to meet producers' financial needs until they can sell their agricultural products. This can provide marketing flexibility by allowing agricultural products to be sold based on market conditions rather than the need for cash.z
