A letter to ACAC (Alberta Colleges Athletic Council) has been signed by all colleges across Alberta stating that their teams won't be participating in ACAC competitions this winter. Kevin also told the board that communication to the college remains a priority through blogs and open forums. Externally, Kevin is involved with the Regional Vitality Project and everything is going well. They have just finished their STEEP analysis and now going into the SWOT stage.

Vicky Roy, VP Academic reported that the search for Dean of Trades and Technology has started. She reported that more resources have been provided to faculty through the CITE centre to help with the transition. A number of program proposals will be submitted to the board early in the new year.

Wayne Resch, VP, Administration & Finance reported about campus access during this COVID pandemic. He mentioned that we are following AHS guidelines and following recommendations from the province to keep the campus safe. Our ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) project is on schedule. Human Resources will be going live January 1 with payroll and Finance will go live July 1. The Health, Wellness and Athletics Expansion (HWAE) are in the final stages of selecting a contractor. Records Information Management (RIM) training has been happening campus wide.
