Students should be advised that a passing grade at Medicine Hat College for non-prerequisite courses is 50%. The minimum required grade for a prerequisite is a C- (56%-59%). However, CPA Alberta requires that students earn a minimum grade of a 60% (C) grade in the courses required for admission to the PEP program. ## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:**
