NOTE: Students who do not achieve a passing grade in a course will be required to repeat it, and must meet with the Department Chair, or designate, or Academic Advisor to determine a progression plan.

All HCA students must successfully complete all coursework, including final course exams, and pass the provincial comprehensive final exam in order to graduate from the program and receive the Government of Alberta Health Care Aide Provincial Curriculum Certificate.
