Post mark and all indicators must confirm that the transcript is issued directly. Document: Official academic transcripts
Post-Secondary Education and Transfer Credit	Issued: Sent directly from the post-secondary institution attended. Transfer Credit: Students will receive an email to their mymhc.ca email account after receiving admission requiring detailed course outlines. For more information, please email transfer@mhc.ab.ca .
English Language Proficiency	 Students should provide one of the following: Successful completion of Advanced ESL (ESL 99) at Medicine Hat College; Successful completion of an Alberta Education English Language Arts course (or Canadian equivalent) that meets the academic requirements of the applicant's intended program of study; A TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of 550 on the paper-based test, a score of 213 on the computer based test, or a score of at least 79 on the TOEFL iBT; An IELTS (International English Language Testing System) overall band score of 6.0 with no band score less than 5.5; Completion of an accredited diploma or degree at a Canadian post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction; or A Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) with a minimum of 7 in each strand (for certificate or diploma programs only).
Acceptable English Translations (if Needed)	Students from Cameroon with a first language of English who complete the GCE examinations and complete a English suitable for their program may be admissible Any documents not issued in English will also need acceptable English translations which: • Must be literal word-for-word translations presenting the same order of information and format as the original. • No information may be left out, altered, or added. This means that all grades, comments, dates, and discussion must be included. • The translation must convey the information and format of the original. • Have an appropriate corresponding original language document on file in the official language via the proper issuing authority. • Arrive separately from the official copies of the transcripts which MUST be issued directly form the institution.
