



ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Students from China require proof of English Language Proficiency. Medicine Hat College requires Academic versions of English language examinations. Students should refer to www.mhc.ab.ca/elp for more information.

Please note that some of our programs require Advanced English Language Proficiency, including *Aviation Management, Child and Youth Care Counsellor, Nursing (*see note on our ELP Page), Occupational Therapist Assistant/Physical Therapist Assistant, Paramedic, Practical Nurse, Social Work, Speech-Language Pathologist Assistant.*

CHINA EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

Students must submit their *Certificate of Graduation from Specialized Senior Secondary School*. An acceptable English translation (*see below notes) must accompany the certificate if it is not in English.

Students who do not have the *Certificate of Graduation from Specialized Senior Secondary School* but have another certificate (e.g., *General Education Examination Certificate*) should e-mail their documents to admissions@mhc.ab.ca. We can then advise if those transcripts can be used for the assessment of the student's application. Please ensure acceptable English translations (*see below notes) accompany any non-English documents.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

Students should submit transcripts from each College/University by e-mail or mail accompanied by an acceptable English translation (*see below notes). Transcripts that are originally in English must be sent directly from the issuing College/University to Medicine Hat College.

Please note that if a student can be admitted solely on their Senior Secondary School results, we will not require Post-Secondary transcripts. However, if a student wishes to be assessed for transfer credit, official transcripts are required.

After being admitted to the program, if a student has provided official Post-Secondary transcripts, the student will receive an e-mail to their mymhc.ca e-mail account requesting detailed course outlines for transfer credit assessment. For more information, please e-mail transfer@mhc.ab.ca.

ADDITIONAL NOTES / REQUIREMENTS

*An acceptable English translation is a certified, literal, word-for-word translation presented in the same order as the original document with no additions, omissions, or alterations. All grades, comments, dates, and discussion included on the original must be included in the translation.
