

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Students from India require proof of English Language Proficiency. Medicine Hat College requires Academic versions of English language examinations. Students should refer to www.mhc.ab.ca/elp for more information.

Please note that some of our programs require Advanced English Language Proficiency, including *Aviation Management*, Child and Youth Care Counsellor, Nursing (*see note on our ELP Page), Occupational Therapist Assistant/Physical Therapist Assistant, Paramedic, Practical Nurse, Social Work, Speech-Language Pathologist Assistant.

INDIA EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

Students must submit their grade 12 Examination Board results. Central Board of Secondary Education results can be verified online back to 2004. Results from 2017 and later will need an admit card to verify the results online. The admit card ID number, school number, and centre number needed for online verification are on the admit card. Other school boards offer online verification limited to the past few years. If an Admissions Officer is unable to verify the student's results online, the student will need to have official transcripts sent from the school or schoolboard to Admissions.

Students may be eligible to use their Vocational Stream for admission to certain non-competitive programs. They may not be used for admission to competitive programs, University Transfer, or University Collaborative programs.

Please note that a passing grade in Alberta is a minimum of 50%.

For the Business Administration Diploma Program ONLY, Accountancy or Economics may be considered in place of Math.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

All academic transcripts should come directly to Medicine Hat College from the issuing institution. Documents will not be considered official unless they are sent directly from the issuing institution.

Please note that if a student can be admitted solely on schoolboard results, we will not require Post-Secondary transcripts. However, if a student wishes to be assessed for transfer credit, official transcripts are required.

After being admitted to the program, if a student has provided official Post-Secondary transcripts, the student will receive an e-mail to their mymhc.ca e-mail account requesting detailed course outlines for transfer credit assessment. For more information, please e-mail transfer@mhc.ab.ca.
