KENYA EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

Medicine Hat College will consider the *Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education* equivalent to Alberta High School transcripts. Please do NOT send high school transcripts, as these cannot be used for admission to the College.

Students must have their KCSE results sent directly to Medicine Hat College from the Kenya National Examinations Council. We will accept mailed copies, but KNEC may also e-mail these to admissions@mhc.ab.ca.

Please note that a passing grade in Alberta is 50%.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

All academic transcripts should come directly to Medicine Hat College from the issuing institution. Documents will not be considered official unless they are sent directly from the issuing institution.

Please note that if a student can be admitted solely on their KNEC results, we will not require Post-Secondary transcripts. However, if a student wishes to be assessed for transfer credit, official transcripts are required.

After being admitted to the program, if a student has provided official Post-Secondary transcripts, the student will receive an e-mail to their mymhc.ca e-mail account requesting detailed course outlines for transfer credit assessment. For more information, please e-mail transfer@mhc.ab.ca.
