## REPUBLIC OF KOREA (South Korea) EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL

Students should provide their Academic High School Leaving Certificate (Immungye Kodung Hakkyo) issued in English and a transcript showing all subjects and grades taken over year 10, 11 and 12.

Transcripts should come directly from the High School to Medicine Hat College in a sealed envelope.

#### POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

All academic transcripts should come directly to Medicine Hat College from the issuing institution. Please see notes on translation below.

#### **ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY**

Students from REPUBLIC OF KOREA (South Korea) require English Language Proficiency. Students who attended a British, Canadian, American or other international school may be exempt from English Language Proficiency but should check if their high school is exempt by emailing <a href="mailto:info@mhc.ab.ca">info@mhc.ab.ca</a>.

## ACCEPTABLE ENGLISH TRANSLATIONS (IF TRANSCRIPT NOT ISSUED IN ENGLISH)

Students should always submit their official documents in the official language of issue. If the language of issue is not English, students should provide an acceptable English translation which should

- Be literal word-for-word translations presenting the same order of information and format as the original.
- Not leave any information out, be altered, or have information added. This means that all grades, comments, dates, and discussion must be included.
- Convey the information and format of the original.
- Have an appropriate corresponding original language document on file in the official language via the proper issuing authority.
