

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Students from the United Kingdom are exempt from providing proof of English Language Proficiency.

UNITED KINGDOM EQUIVALENT TO ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

Region: England, Wales, and Northern Ireland

Students can submit their *General Certificate of Secondary Education* or (for students who completed their examinations prior to 1986) *O-Level GCE* results. For English and Mathematics, the GCSE/GCE O-Levels match the Alberta 30-2 stream (this may limit a student's admissibility to some of our programs).

Students who have taken *Advanced General Certificate of Education* (A-Level) examinations should submit these results as they are comparable to Alberta's 30-1 stream. These are considered the main route to higher education.

Region: Scotland

Students can submit their *Scottish Qualifications Certificate* or (for students who completed their examinations prior to 2000) *Scottish Certificate of Education*. For English and Mathematics, the Standard Grades are considered equivalent to the Alberta 30-2 stream (this may limit a student's admissibility to some of our programs).

National Courses at Higher and Advanced Higher levels will be considered equivalent to Alberta's 30-1 stream. These levels are considered the main route to higher education.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRANSFER CREDIT

All academic transcripts should come directly to Medicine Hat College from the issuing institution. Documents will not be considered official unless they are sent directly from the issuing institution.

Please note that if a student can be admitted solely on their GCE/GCSE or SQC/SCE results, we will not require Post-Secondary transcripts. However, if a student wishes to be assessed for transfer credit, official transcripts are required.

After being admitted to the program, if a student has provided official Post-Secondary transcripts, the student will receive an e-mail to their mymhc.ca e-mail account requesting detailed course outlines for transfer credit assessment. For more information, please e-mail <u>transfer@mhc.ab.ca</u>.
