DO I NEED A STUDY PERMIT?

Most students require a study permit to pursue post-secondary education in Canada. You can apply for a study permit after you are admitted into a program at MHC.

Please review application details outlined by the Government of Canada early, as requirements (which may include biometrics) vary by country. Processing time varies by country, but typically ranges between 3-12 weeks or longer.

HOW MUCH MONEY WILL I NEED TO SUPPORT MYSELF IN MY STUDIES?

To obtain a study permit, you must prove to the Government of Canada (IRCC) that you can support yourself while in Canada without the need to work. You must demonstrate that you have enough funds to cover full tuition fees for the first year of your program, one year living expenses in Canada, and travel expenses from your home country to Canada.
