HOW TO REGISTER OR APPLY

Register for our courses online, by telephone or in person.

ONLINE SELF REGISTRATION

Register online 24 hours a day, seven days a week via our Lumens system using your Visa®, Visa® Debit, Mastercard® or American Express®.

Before registering for a course online, you must create a profile for yourself.

To do so, follow these steps:


1. Head to the Lumens website: [Lumens](#)
2. Click on LOGIN/CREATE ACCOUNT
3. Click on CREATE NEW PROFILE
4. Select STUDENT PROFILE (single user).

After you have logged in or created a new account, follow the steps below to add the course to your cart and complete your purchase:

1. Locate the desired course
 - a. Do this by searching key words in the course name such as Paramedic or course number 6010001 or Select School of Health & Community Services under the Leading Industry heading on All Classes page.
