

How to use Transfer Alberta

http://transferalberta.alberta.ca/

The Government of Alberta created the Transfer Alberta database to catalogue how courses transfer between institutions in Alberta. Post-secondary institutions in Alberta signed agreements outlining which courses are similar and transfer.

You can use the <u>Transfer Alberta Search Tool</u> to check how courses and programs transfer. Use the Transfer Alberta Search Tool to find which Medicine Hat College courses may transfer to a University or which University courses may have transfer courses at Medicine Hat College. 7. For example, if your program requires a chemistry course you can type in "chem" under "Filter by Course or Keyword" and the Search will filter out.



- 8. Checking the box beside the courses tells the Search these are the courses you want to look up for transfer. You can check off all the courses required for your program.
- 9. You will also need to "Select a Year" for when you plan to take the course(s).



10. Hit "Next" to look up how the course(s) transfers. The Search will show you how the course(s) transfers.



- 11. In this example, we can see Medicine Hat College's CHEM 201 transfers to the University of Alberta as CHEM 101 This means, if the degree you are working towards at the University of Alberta requires CHEM 101 and you take CHEM 201 at Medicine Hat College and then apply to transfer to the University of Alberta, you will likely get transfer credit for CHEM 101 at the University.
- 12. If you click "View Transfer Details" for each one of these course transfers, you will also see a brief course description and other important notes about transfer credit for the course.



13. You can also download your results or save the search for later.

Frequently Asked Questions

What does it mean when a course transfers as ENGL 1xx: Unspecified Credit?

It means the course transfers as an English class (ENGL). It transfers at the 100-level (1xx), which is first year. The course is just not transferring as a specific course (Unspecific Course). This is fine if you do not need specific English courses for your program.

What does it mean when a course transfers as Option 2xx: Unspecified Course?

Option 2xx: Unspecified Course: This means the course transfers as an option / elective course. The course does not transfer as a specific subject or course, but a student may be able to use it towards the option or elective requirement within their degree. The course transfers at the 200-level (2xx).

What does it mean when a course transfers as Option Sr.: Unspecified Course?

Option Sr.: Unspecified Course: This means the course transfers as an option / elective course. The course does not transfer as a specific subject or course, but a student may be able to use it towards the option or elective requirement within their degree. Sr. means senior, which is 300-level (third year) or 400-level (fourth year).

I cannot find a course in Transfer Alberta. Does that mean it does not transfer?

If a course does not show up in Transfer Alberta, there is likely not a formal transfer agreement for it. The course may still transfer. You need to talk to the institution you are planning to attend to find out.

How can I search a course(s) for transfer to an institution outside of Alberta?

A few institutions from outside Alberta are part of Transfer Alberta – University of Regina and Thompson Rivers University, Open Learning. Some universities do have transfer databases on their websites you can use to get an idea of possible transfer credit.

Transfer Tips

The institution you apply to will make the final decision about your transfer credit.

Always confirm your Transfer Alberta results with the post-secondary institution/university you are planning to attend.

Some courses at Medicine Hat College count as a 4-credit course but only transfer as a 3-credit course to other postsecondary institutions/universities. You can see how many credits a course for transfer is worth by clicking "View Transfer Details" (step 12). You need to count your credits based off of how much the course is worth at the post-secondary institution/university you plan to attend after Medicine Hat College.

A course may transfer to the institution but still not count towards your degree. This may happen because:

- You have taken too many courses for transfer.
- There is no spot in your degree/program for the course.

Some courses must be taken as a group in order to receive transfer credit*:

- Students must take ENGL 202 and ENGL 203 at MHC in order to receive transfer credit for ENGL 1900 and ENGL 2xxx at University of Lethbridge.
- Students must take BIOL 231 and BIOL 233 at MHC in order to receive transfer credit for BIOL 241 and BIOL 243 at University of Calgary.
- Students must take KNES 261, PHSL 370, and PHSL 371 at MHC in order to receive transfer credit for KNES 259, KNES 260, and KNES 323 at University of Calgary.

*MHC Academic Advisors provide this information in this document as an example of group course transfer agreements. Transfer agreements can change. This information was accurate at the time of publication. Students must verify the transfer by reviewing the information on Transfer Alberta or by contacting the university they hope to attend.

University of Alberta has two campuses in Alberta: the main campus in Edmonton, Alberta and Augustana Campus in Camrose, Alberta. Courses transfer differently to each campus. Courses with "AU" listed before the course code indicate how the courses transfer to the Augustana Campus. For example, CHEM 201 from MHC transfers to the Augustana Campus as AUCHE 110. CHEM 201 from MHC transfers to the main U of A campus as CHEM 101.

If a course does not show up in Transfer Alberta, there is likely not a formal transfer agreement for it. The course may still transfer. You need to talk to the institution you are planning to attend to find out.
